



Introduction and Setup

Thank you for purchasing our USB buzzers. The USB buzzers are designed for easy set-up utilizing the built-in keyboard drivers of the operating system (Windows 98 and above). Our standard three player USB buzzers come preprogrammed to generate keystrokes 1, 2 and 3. However, based on the user's specification at the time of ordering, it is possible for us to preprogram the USB buzzers, to generate a variety of keystrokes for maximizing versatility with a variety of software. We can preprogram any buzzer to simulate keys 0-9 on the keyboard. Quick steps for using your USB buzzers are below.

Quick Setup:

(1) Determine which keyboard activated software application you plan to use with the USB buzzers and open that application.

(2) Plug the USB buzzer into the PC's USB port. If prompted for a driver, place the operating system's disk in the disk drive and direct the system to look for the driver on that corresponding disk. Follow driver instructions to complete installation.

(3) Begin pressing the USB buzzer to send keystroke information to the open application, i.e, keyboard strokes 1,2 or 3 for the standard factory preprogrammed buzzers. The character corresponding to each respective buzzer should be generated for the open application. If you are not getting the expected response from the application based on pressing the buzzer, open a text program like Notepad to check if the appropriate characters are being generated. If not, try unplugging the buzzer/s wait 3 to 4 seconds and re-plug the USB buzzer back into the port/s.

Note, once the operating system finds the appropriate drivers for the USB buzzers after the initial install, it will quickly recognize the buzzers once disconnected and reconnected again.

That's it! Have fun with your new USB buzzers and remember that the buzzers are made to generate keystrokes to any application that accepts keyboard information. You have purchased the most versatile and mobile buzzers on the market.

Maximum Number of Buzzers

You can theoretically have up to 127 USB buzzers connected to a single computer, however these buzzers will have to be powered from external USB hubs. Four and Seven port USB hubs will provide the flexibility to accommodate a variety of player combinations.
